14 WHEREAS, Rule 7.23 of the Rules of the House of Representatives
15 of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature requires the Calendar Committee to
16 propose a regular order of business for the House of

5 be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;
- 6 4. Introduction of the Veteran of the Week, the timing of which
7 shall be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;
- 8 5. Pledge of Allegiance, the timing of which shall be left to
9 the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;
- 10 6. Correction of the Previous Day's Journal;
- 11 7. House and Senate Bills and Joint Resolutions on Second
12 Reading, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the
13 Majority Floor Leader;
- 14 8. Assignment or Reassignment of Bills and Resolutions, the
15 timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority
16 Floor Leader;
- 17 9. House and Senate Bills and Joint Resolutions on the Consent
18 Calendar;
- 19 10. Bills, Resolutions, Conference Committee Reports and Joint
20 Committee Reports scheduled by the House Calendar Committee; and
- 21 11. Motions placing new business before the House. The
22 Majority Floor Leader shall schedule said motions upon the same
