8 AS INTRODUCED

9 A Resolution stating legislative intent that the
10 State Board of Education adopt certain curriculum and
11 standards pursuant to the Administrative Procedures
12 Act; and directing distribution.

13
14 WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon legislators to prudently assess
15 the policies and procedures in every area of government, but most
16 especially those policies and procedures in the largest area of
17 state government, which is common education; and

18 WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon legislators to assess the impact
19 of adopting the Common Core State Standards, in their entirety, on
20 the state subject matter curriculum along with the concomitant
21 changes to Oklahoma education, including but not limited to vast
22 changes in testing, textbooks, teacher evaluation, and school
23 performance; and

1 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-103.6a of Title 70 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes, the State Board of Education has the authority to
3 adopt and review subject matter curriculum and the Legislature
4 should review and assess the adoption of such curriculum.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
6 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

7 THAT it is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that adoption
8 of subject matter curriculum, including but not limited to adoption
9 of the Common Core State Standards, by the State Board of Education
10 shall be made pursuant to and shall be subject to approval under
11 Article I of the Administrative Procedures Act and that the Board
12 shall promulgate rules for any revisions of such curriculum deemed
13 necessary to achieve further improvements in the quality of
14 education for students of this state.

15 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the State Board
16 of Education and the State Superintendent of Public Instruction.
