9                   A Resolution relating to the House of  
10                  Representatives; establishing an order of business  
11                  for the House of Representatives for the Second  
12                  Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature.

13                  WHEREAS, Rule 7.23 of the Rules of the House of Representatives  
14                  of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature requires the Calendar Committee to  
15                  propose a regular order of business for the House of  
16                  Representatives; and

17                  WHEREAS, pursuant to House Rule 7.23, the Calendar Committee  
18                  hereby proposes for consideration by the House of Representatives  
19                  the following daily order of business for the House of  
20                  Representatives for the Second Session of the 54th Oklahoma  
21                  Legislature.

22                  NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
23                  OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

24                  THAT the following Order of Business shall be followed each day:

- 1 1. Roll Call;
- 2 2. Prayer, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion  
3 of the Majority Floor Leader;
- 4 3. Inspirational Message by Chaplain on Thursday mornings, the  
5 timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority  
6 Floor Leader;
- 7 4. Introduction of the Veteran of the Week on Monday mornings,  
8 the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority  
9 Floor Leader;
- 10 5. Pledge of Allegiance on Monday mornings, the timing of which  
11 shall be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;
- 12 6. Introduction of a Doctor and/or Nurse of the Day, the timing  
13 of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor  
14 Leader;
- 15 7. Correction of the Previous Day's Journal;
- 16 8. House and Senate Bills and Joint Resolutions on Second  
17 Reading, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the  
18 Majority Floor Leader;
- 19 9. Assignment or Reassignment of Bills and Resolutions, the  
20 timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority  
21 Floor Leader;
- 22 10. House and Senate Bills and Joint Resolutions on the Consent  
23 Calendar;

1 11. Bills, Resolutions, Conference Committee Reports and Joint  
2 Committee Reports scheduled by the House Calendar Committee; and

3 12. Motions placing new business before the House. The  
4 Majority Floor Leader shall schedule said motions upon the same  
5 legislative day, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion  
6 of the Majority Floor Leader.
