



1 person authorized to provide food services through the Business  
2 Enterprise Program.

3 B. The Department of Rehabilitation Services may also establish  
4 an e-commerce site for the support of such catering services and  
5 food services for the Business Enterprise Program operating in the  
6 State Capitol complex. It shall allow for online ordering and the  
7 receipt of payments online. The Legislative Service Bureau and the  
8 Office of Management and Enterprise Services are authorized to  
9 provide links to any such e-commerce site.

10 C. Any outside vendors contracting to provide services shall  
11 only be allowed to operate during the months of February through May  
12 in temporary facilities, which shall be easily moveable and not  
13 require any significant remodeling, in the State Capitol complex.  
14 Such facilities shall be approved by the State Capitol Building  
15 Manager.

16 D. Any agency affected by the provisions of this act shall be  
17 authorized to promulgate any rules deemed necessary to implement the  
18 provisions of this act.

19 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
