



1 fire drills shall include the sounding of a distinctive audible  
2 signal designated as the fire alarm signal;

3 2. Two intruder drills per school year. Intruder drills are  
4 conducted for the purpose of mitigating injuries or deaths by  
5 executing a plan as an alternative to the lockdown method. Each  
6 intruder drill shall be conducted within the first fifteen (15) days  
7 of each semester;

8 3. Two tornado drills per school year with at least one drill  
9 being conducted in the months of September and March; and

10 4. The principal and superintendent of a public school district  
11 shall utilize the remaining required safety drills in any manner  
12 provided in this section or Section 5-148 of ~~Title 70 of the~~  
13 ~~Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title or by developing a drill that is  
14 consistent with the risks assessed for the appropriate facility or  
15 any recommendations submitted by the Safe School Committee as  
16 authorized pursuant to Section 24-100.5 of ~~Title 70 of the Oklahoma~~  
17 ~~Statutes~~ this title or any assisting fire or law enforcement  
18 department.

19 B. It shall be the duty of the principal, under the direction  
20 of the superintendent of the school district, to conform to the  
21 written plans and procedures adopted by the district as required by  
22 Section 681 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes. All students and  
23 teachers at the public schools shall participate; provided, however,  
24

1 that the extent of student involvement required in paragraph 2 of  
2 subsection A of this section be determined by the district.

3 C. Each public school district shall document each fire drill  
4 in writing by public school site. The records for each fire drill  
5 shall be preserved for at least three years and made available to  
6 the State Fire Marshal or the marshal's agent upon request. In  
7 addition to the fire drill documentation provided in this  
8 subsection, the school district shall document all other safety  
9 drills in writing and by school site with a copy of the report  
10 remaining at the school, a copy filed with the district  
11 administrative office and a copy with the Institute for School  
12 Security Resources as created by the Oklahoma Office of Homeland  
13 Security.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.

15 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
