10 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to journeyman plumbers and plumbing
12 contractors; amending 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1006,
13 which relates to journeyman plumbers and plumbing
14 contractor licenses; directing adoption of rules and
15 procedures for certain military training; and
16 providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1006, is
19 amended to read as follows:

20 Section 1006. A. The Construction Industries Board shall issue
21 licenses to persons who have been certified by the Board as having
22 successfully passed the examination for journeyman plumber or
23 plumbing contractor, as the case may be, and who have paid the fees

1 and have otherwise complied with the applicable requirements of The
2 Plumbing License Law of 1955.

3 B. All licenses shall be nontransferable. It shall be unlawful
4 for any holder of a license under The Plumbing License Law of 1955
5 to loan or allow the use of such license by any other person, firm
6 or corporation, except as specifically provided in The Plumbing
7 License Law of 1955.

8 C. The Board shall adopt procedures and rules to review and
9 accept proof and documentation of an applicant's qualified training
10 and experience as a journeyman plumber or plumbing contractor while
11 on active duty with the armed forces of the United States when such
12 service member has been discharged from active duty within one (1)
13 year of the application for examination or licensure in this state
14 as a journeyman plumber or plumbing contractor.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
