

1 3. Any retail establishment which provides adult-oriented
2 entertainment in which performers disrobe or perform in an unclothed
3 state for entertainment; or

4 4. Any retail establishment whose principal business is that of
5 selling cigarettes, cigar or tobacco products.

6 B. For the purposes of this act:

7 1. "Liquor store" means any retail establishment that sells
8 exclusively or primarily intoxicating liquor but does not include a
9 grocery store that sells both intoxicating liquor and groceries;

10 2. "Casino", "gambling casino" and "gaming establishment" do
11 not include:

12 a. a grocery store that sells groceries and that also
13 offers, or is located within the same building or
14 complex as an establishment that offers casino,
15 gambling or gaming activities, or

16 b. any other establishment that offers casino, gambling
17 or gaming activities incidental to the principal
18 purpose of the business; and

19 3. "Electronic benefit transfer transaction" means the use of a
20 credit or debit card service, automated teller machine, point-of-
21 sale terminal or access to an online system for the withdrawal of
22 funds or the processing of a payment for merchandise or service.

1 C. An individual who violates the provisions of this section
2 shall be subject to a reduction in Temporary Assistance for Needy
3 Families (TANF) benefits as follows:

4 1. For the first violation, twenty-five percent (25%) of the
5 individual's TANF payment standard for a period of three (3) months;

6 2. A second violation following the three (3) month reduction
7 in benefits shall result in a thirty-five percent (35%) reduction in
8 TANF benefits for six (6) subsequent months;

9 3. A third violation following the six (6) month reduction in
10 benefits shall result in a fifty percent (50%) reduction in TANF
11 benefits for twelve (12) subsequent months; and

12 4. Subsequent violations shall result in the individual being
13 deemed permanently ineligible for TANF benefits. Individuals with
14 children receiving TANF benefits shall only be eligible to receive
15 benefit payments for dependent children as provided by state and
16 federal law.

17 ~~C.~~ D. By August 1, 2013, the Oklahoma Department of Human
18 Services shall report on the status of an implementation plan
19 pursuant to the provisions of this section. The President Pro
20 Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
21 Representatives shall be provided with updates on the status of
22 implementation on a quarterly basis until provisions of this section
23 are fully implemented by the Department.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
