7 Duties designed to improve the lives of children of incarcerated

- 9 a. coordinating research,
- 10 b. collecting data,
- 11 c. creating a resource clearinghouse,
- 12 d. developing an educational toolkit describing services  
13 available to children of incarcerated parents, and
- 14 e. coordinating an advisory committee to work  
15 collaboratively with agencies and service providers to  
16 better meet the needs and improve the quality of life  
17 for children of incarcerated parents; and

18 5. Conduct or otherwise provide continuing professional  
19 education and training for the purposes of improving services to  
20 children.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
