

1 superintendent of the receiving school district for transfers to
2 school districts in the State of Oklahoma and with the State Board
3 of Education for transfers to school districts in another state.
4 Except as otherwise provided for in this section, applications shall
5 be filed no later than ~~April 1~~ May 31 of the school year preceding
6 the school year for which the transfer is desired. By ~~April 1~~ May
7 31 of the same school year, the receiving school district shall
8 notify the resident school district that an application for transfer
9 has been filed by a student enrolled in the resident school
10 district. The board of education of the receiving school district
11 shall approve or deny the application for transfer not later than
12 ~~June 1~~ July 15 of the same year and shall notify the parents of the
13 student of the decision. By ~~July 1~~ August 1 of the same year, the
14 parents of the student shall notify the receiving school district
15 that the student will be enrolling in that school district. Failure
16 of parents to notify the district as required may result in loss of
17 the student's right to enroll in the district for that year.

18 B. On or before September 1, it shall be the duty of the
19 superintendent of the receiving school district to file with the
20 State Board of Education and each resident district a statement
21 showing the names of the students granted transfers to the school
22 district, the resident school district of the transferred students
23 and their respective grade level.

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1 C. The receiving school district of a student transferred
2 pursuant to the provisions of this act shall notify the resident
3 school district and parents of the student of a cancellation of the
4 transfer. Such notice shall be made by ~~June 1~~ July 15 prior to the
5 school year for which the cancellation is applicable.

6 D. For students who are deaf or hearing impaired who wish to
7 transfer to a school district with a specialized deaf education
8 program, applications may be filed at any time during the school
9 year. Upon approval of the receiving school district, the student
10 may transfer to the receiving school district at any time during the
11 school year.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
