

1 1. Nine members to be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of
2 the Senate as follows:

- 3 a. three members of the Senate Education Committee,
- 4 b. a representative of a statewide organization that
5 represents teachers,
- 6 c. three public school district superintendents, and
- 7 d. two public high school students;

8 2. Eight members to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of
9 Representatives as follows:

- 10 a. three members of the House Common Education Committee,
- 11 b. a representative of a statewide organization that
12 represents school boards,
- 13 c. three public school principals or vice principals, and
- 14 d. one public high school student;

15 4. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction, or designee;

16 5. The Chair and Vice Chair of the Senate Education Committee;

17 and

18 6. The Chair and Vice Chair of the House Common Education
19 Committee.

20 C. The task force shall be co-chaired by the Chair of the
21 Senate Education Committee and the Chair of the House Common
22 Education Committee.

23 D. Appointments to the task force shall be made no later than
24 August 1, 2013.

1 E. A quorum of the task force shall be required to approve any
2 final action of the task force. For purposes of this section,
3 twelve (12) members shall constitute a quorum.

4 F. The task force may meet as often as may be required in order
5 to perform the duties imposed upon it.

6 G. The meetings of the task force shall be subject to the
7 Oklahoma Open Meeting Act.

8 H. Members of the task force shall receive no compensation for
9 serving on the task force but shall receive travel reimbursement as
10 follows:

11 1. State employees who are members of the task force shall be
12 reimbursed for travel expenses incurred in the performance of their
13 duties by their respective agencies in accordance with the State
14 Travel Reimbursement Act;

15 2. Legislative members shall be reimbursed in accordance with
16 Section 456 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

17 3. All other task force members shall be reimbursed by the
18 appointing authority for travel expenses incurred in the performance
19 of their duties in accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement
20 Act.

21 I. Staff support shall be provided by the State Department of
22 Education, Senate and House of Representatives.

23 J. The task force shall submit a report by December 1, 2013, of
24 its findings and recommendations to the Governor, the President Pro

1 Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
2 Representatives.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
