11                                   COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12                   An Act relating to chiropractic procedures; creating  
13                   the Task Force on Neck Manipulation; designating  
14                   membership and appointing authorities; providing for  
15                   date of appointments; providing for vacancies;  
16                   providing for frequency of meetings; providing for  
17                   quorum; providing travel reimbursement for members;  
18                   providing certain duties; providing for staff  
19                   assistance; providing for noncodification; providing  
20                   an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22                   SECTION 1.           NEW LAW           A new section of law not to be  
23                   codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:  
24

1        There is hereby created, to continue until December 31, 2013, in  
2 accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law, a Task  
3 Force on Neck Manipulation.

4        SECTION 2.        NEW LAW        A new section of law not to be  
5 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

6        A.    There is hereby created a ten-member Task Force on Neck  
7 Manipulation.    The membership of the task force shall be as follows:

8            1.    The President of the Board of Chiropractic Examiners, or a  
9 designee;

10           2.    Two representatives from the chiropractic medicine industry,  
11 appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and Speaker of  
12 the House of Representatives, respectively;

13           3.    Two Senators, appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the  
14 Senate;

15           4.    Two Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the House  
16 of Representatives;

17           5.    A representative from the Oklahoma State Medical  
18 Association;

19           6.    A representative from the Oklahoma Osteopathic Association;  
20 and

21           7.    A representative from the Oklahoma Physical Therapy  
22 Association.

23        B.    Appointments to the task force shall be made by August 1,  
24 2013.    Members shall serve at the pleasure of their appointing

1 authority. A vacancy on the task force shall be filled by the  
2 original appointing authority.

3 C. The task force may meet monthly and at other such times as  
4 deemed necessary by members. A majority of members present at a  
5 meeting shall constitute a quorum to transact business and a  
6 majority present may act for the task force.

7 D. Members of the task force shall receive no compensation for  
8 their service, but shall be reimbursed for their actual and  
9 necessary travel expenses as follows:

10 1. Nonlegislative members who are state officers or employees  
11 shall be reimbursed by their respective agencies for their necessary  
12 travel expenses incurred in the performance of their duties in  
13 accordance with the provisions of the State Travel Reimbursement  
14 Act;

15 2. Members who are not legislators or officers or employees of  
16 the state shall be reimbursed by their appointing authorities in  
17 accordance with the provisions of the State Travel Reimbursement  
18 Act; and

19 3. Legislative members shall be reimbursed for their necessary  
20 travel expenses incurred in the performance of their duties in  
21 accordance with Section 456 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

22 E. The Task Force on Neck Manipulation shall examine risks,  
23 benefits, and alternatives to procedures associated with manual and  
24 manipulative treatment of the cervical spine. The task force shall

1 also determine the necessity of informing patients of possible side  
2 effects resulting from treatments of the cervical spine.

3 F. The Senate shall provide staff assistance to the Task Force  
4 on Neck Manipulation.

5 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

6 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
