

1 B. It shall be unlawful for any member of the county excise
2 board to sell or contract to sell, or to lease or contract to lease,
3 or to represent any person, firm, corporation or association in the
4 sale or the lease of any machinery, supplies, equipment, material,
5 or other goods, wares, or merchandise to any county or city or town
6 of the county. It shall also be unlawful for any member of the
7 county excise board to serve as employee, official, or attorney for
8 any county or city, or town of the county, or for any such member to
9 represent any taxpayer before such board in any manner, or to use
10 his or her position as a board member to further his or her own
11 interests. It shall also be unlawful for any taxpayer or interested
12 party to employ any member of the county excise board in any matter
13 coming before the board.

14 C. The members of county excise boards in all counties ~~having~~
15 ~~an assessed valuation of Two Billion Dollars (\$2,000,000,000.00) or~~
16 ~~more shall receive as compensation an amount not to exceed Seventy-~~
17 ~~five Dollars (\$75.00) per day. The members of county excise boards~~
18 ~~in all other counties may~~ shall receive as compensation an amount
19 ~~not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per day, said amount to be~~
20 ~~established by the boards~~ board of county commissioners for the
21 county in which they serve but not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)
22 per day.

23 In addition, the members of county excise boards shall be
24 reimbursed for each mile of travel to and from their residences to

1 the place of meeting of the board for each session attended at the
2 rate provided for other county officers. The members of county
3 excise boards shall be also reimbursed for each mile of necessary
4 travel in the performance of their official duties at the same rate.

5 The total number of days in each year for which the members of
6 said board may be paid shall be as follows:

7 In counties having an assessed valuation of Forty Million
8 Dollars (\$40,000,000.00) and less, not to exceed sixty (60) days;

9 In counties having an assessed valuation of more than Forty
10 Million Dollars (\$40,000,000.00) and not more than Eighty Million
11 Dollars (\$80,000,000.00), not to exceed sixty-five (65) days;

12 In counties having an assessed valuation of more than Eighty
13 Million Dollars (\$80,000,000.00) and not more than Five Hundred
14 Million Dollars (\$500,000,000.00), not to exceed one hundred (100)
15 days;

16 In counties having an assessed valuation of more than Five
17 Hundred Million Dollars (\$500,000,000.00), not to exceed two hundred
18 fifty (250) days.

19 D. Any person violating any of the provisions of this section
20 shall be deemed guilty of a felony, and upon conviction thereof
21 shall be punished by a fine of not less than Two Hundred Dollars
22 (\$200.00) and not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or by
23 imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for not less than six (6)

1 months or more than two (2) years, or by both such fine and
2 imprisonment.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
