



1 consist of monies received by the State Department of Health which  
2 emanate from fines and assessments against Oklahoma nursing homes  
3 and other long-term and non-long-term care facilities found to be  
4 noncompliant with federal conditions of participation.

5 B. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby  
6 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the State  
7 Department of Health at the discretion of the Commissioner of Health  
8 for the protection of the health or property of residents of nursing  
9 facilities.

10 C. All expenditures shall be in compliance with requirements of  
11 the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. Expenditures from  
12 the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer  
13 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the  
14 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and  
15 payment.

16 D. The Commissioner of Health may request the Director of the  
17 Office of Management and Enterprise Services to transfer monies  
18 between the Oklahoma Department of Health Civil Monetary Penalty  
19 Revolving Fund and any other fund of the Department, as needed for  
20 the proper expenditure of funds.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
