

1 website, the insurer shall ensure that the policies and endorsements
2 are posted in a manner that complies with the following conditions:

3 1. The policy and endorsements shall be easily accessible;

4 2. The insurer shall archive all policies and endorsements for
5 a period of five (5) years after the expiration of the policy;

6 3. All policies and endorsements shall be posted in a manner
7 that allows an insured to print and save electronic copies of the
8 documents;

9 4. The insurer shall provide notice at the time of issuance of
10 the initial policy forms and upon renewal of a method by which the
11 insured may obtain, without charge, a paper or electronic copy of
12 the insured's policy and endorsements;

13 5. Each declaration page issued to an insured shall clearly
14 identify the policy and endorsement forms purchased by the insured;
15 and

16 6. The insurer shall provide notice of any changes to the forms
17 or endorsements and of the insured's right to obtain, without
18 charge, paper or electronic copies of the forms in the manner the
19 insurer customarily communicates with the insured.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
