

1 deductible, or other out-of-pocket expense that does not apply to
2 intravenously administered or injected cancer medication, regardless
3 of formulation or benefit category determination by the company
4 administering the health benefit plan.

5 3. A health benefit plan shall not reclassify or increase any
6 type of cost-sharing to the covered person for anticancer
7 medications in order to achieve compliance with this section. Any
8 change in health insurance coverage that otherwise increases an out-
9 of-pocket expense to anticancer medications shall also be applied to
10 the majority of comparable medical or pharmaceutical benefits
11 covered by the health benefit plan.

12 4. A health benefit plan that limits the total amount paid by a
13 covered person through all cost-sharing requirements to no more than
14 One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per filled prescription for any orally
15 administered anticancer medication shall be considered in compliance
16 with this section. For purposes of this paragraph, "cost-sharing
17 requirements" shall include copayments, coinsurance, deductibles,
18 and any other amounts paid by the covered person for that
19 prescription.

20 B. As used in this section:

21 1. "Anticancer medications" means medications used to kill or
22 slow the growth of cancer cells;

1 2. "Covered person" means a policyholder, subscriber, enrollee,
2 or other individual enrolled in or insured by a health benefit plan
3 for health insurance coverage; and

4 3. "Health benefit plan" means any plan or arrangement as
5 defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of Title 36 of the
6 Oklahoma Statutes.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
