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9 An Act relating to counties; amending 19 O.S. 2011,
10 Sections 130.2 and 130.6, which relate to the
11 Commission on County Government Personnel Education
12 and Training; modifying duties of the Commission;
13 modifying payment of expenses; providing an effective
14 date; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 130.2, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 130.2. The duties of the Commission shall be:

19 1. To oversee a professional development program for training
20 Oklahoma county commissioners, county clerks, county treasurers,
21 county assessors, court clerks, their deputies and employees, county
22 sheriffs, excise board members, and other political subdivisions
23 through the Cooperative Extension Service at Oklahoma State
24 University;

1 2. To provide guidance to the Cooperative Extension Service in
2 designing curricula to be used in educational programs and
3 materials;

4 3. To identify needs and set priorities for research to be
5 conducted in cooperation with the Cooperative Extension Service in
6 areas relevant to the study and improvement of Oklahoma county
7 government and its functions and to accept gifts and grants for such
8 purposes;

9 4. To cooperate with the advisory boards authorized in Section
10 130.4 of this title in determining the educational needs of county
11 officials and their employees so that they can perform their duties
12 and responsibilities efficiently and professionally; and

13 5. To contract with the Cooperative Extension Service at
14 Oklahoma State University to administer personnel education and
15 training for counties and other political subdivisions.

16 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 130.6, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 130.6. A. 1. Any professional or clerical support
19 staff required by the Commission on County Government Personnel
20 Education and Training shall be provided through the Cooperative
21 Extension Service.

22 2. The training programs developed pursuant to ~~Sections~~ Section
23 130.1 through 130.7 et seq. of this title shall not interfere with
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1 or duplicate any other existing training programs for county
2 government personnel.

3 B. ~~All expenses~~ Expenses incurred in the performance of the
4 duties imposed upon the Commission by law shall primarily be paid
5 out of funds appropriated or otherwise made available to the Office
6 of the State Auditor and Inspector and may also be paid by the
7 collection of training expenses paid by the counties directly to the
8 Cooperative Extension Service.

9 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

10 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
