12 An Act relating to state government; creating the
13 Joint Legislative Committee on Accountability;
14 specifying powers and duties of Committee; requiring
15 State Auditor and Inspector to conduct certain audit;
16 defining term; providing for codification; and
17 providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 465.10 of Title 74, unless there
21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A. There is hereby created the Joint Legislative Committee on
23 Accountability.

24 B. The Committee shall consist of the following:

1 1. An even number, to be mutually agreed upon with the
2 President Pro Tempore of the Senate, of appointees to be selected by
3 the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

4 2. An odd number, to be mutually agreed upon with the Speaker
5 of the House of Representatives, of appointees to be selected by the
6 President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and

7 3. Such appointments shall include two members from the private
8 sector, with current significant business experience in internal
9 auditing and performance auditing. These members shall serve with
10 no compensation but shall be allowed travel reimbursement as
11 provided by state law.

12 C. The Joint Legislative Committee on Accountability shall
13 undertake a review of executive branch entities and shall perform
14 such duties as the Speaker and the President Pro Tempore may direct.

15 D. The State Auditor and Inspector shall conduct or shall cause
16 to be conducted a performance audit of any executive entity of state
17 government upon the recommendation to perform such audit by the
18 Joint Legislative Committee on Accountability subject to the
19 availability of funds for such purpose. The provisions of this
20 subsection shall be in addition to the provisions of Section 213.2
21 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

22 E. As used in this section, "performance audit" means an audit
23 of a program, activity, or function of a state agency conducted in
24 accordance with applicable Government Audit Standards. The term

1 includes, but is not limited to, an audit to assess program,
2 activity, or function effectiveness, economy and efficiency,
3 internal control, or compliance.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
