10 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to sex offenders registration;
12 amending 57 O.S. 2011, Section 587, which relates to
13 penalties for failing to register as a sex offender;
14 increasing penalty for failure to register; and
15 providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2011, Section 587, is
19 amended to read as follows:

20 Section 587. A. Any person required to register pursuant to
21 the provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act who violates
22 any provision of said act shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a
23 felony. Any person convicted of a violation of this section shall
24 be punished by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of

1 Corrections for not ~~more~~ less than five (5) years nor more than ten
2 (10) years, a fine not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00),
3 or both such fine and imprisonment.

4 B. Any person required to register pursuant to the Sex
5 Offenders Registration Act who fails to comply with the established
6 guidelines for global position system (GPS) monitoring shall, upon
7 conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by a fine not to exceed
8 One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by imprisonment in the custody
9 of the county jail for not more than one (1) year, or by both such
10 fine and imprisonment.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
