

1 legal parent or legal guardian before a person authorized to
2 administer oaths or a notarized affidavit signed by a custodial
3 legal parent or legal guardian submitted by the person under the age
4 of eighteen (18) years with the application. Except as otherwise
5 provided in this section, the identification cards shall be valid
6 for a period of four (4) years from the month of issuance; however,
7 the identification cards issued to persons sixty-five (65) years of
8 age or older shall be valid indefinitely from the month of issuance.

9 B. The fee charged for the issuance, renewal, or replacement of
10 an identification card pursuant to this section shall be Ten Dollars
11 (\$10.00); however, no person sixty-five (65) years of age or older
12 shall be charged a fee for an identification card. Of each fee
13 charged pursuant to the provisions of this subsection:

14 1. Seven Dollars (\$7.00) shall be apportioned as provided in
15 Section 1104 of this title; and

16 2. Three Dollars (\$3.00) shall be credited to the Department of
17 Public Safety Computer Imaging System Revolving Fund to be used
18 solely for the purpose of the administration and maintenance of the
19 computerized imaging system of the Department.

20 C. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby authorized to
21 reimburse, from funds available to that agency, each motor license
22 agent issuing an identification card to a person sixty-five (65)
23 years of age or older, an amount not to exceed One Dollar (\$1.00)

1 for each card or driver license so issued. The Tax Commission shall
2 develop procedures for claims for reimbursement.

3 D. When a person makes application for a new identification
4 card, or makes application to renew an identification card, and the
5 person has been convicted of, or received a deferred judgment for,
6 any offense required to register pursuant to the Sex Offenders
7 Registration Act, the identification card shall be valid for a
8 period of one (1) year from the month of issuance, but may be
9 renewed yearly during the time the person is registered on the Sex
10 Offender Registry. The cost for such identification card shall be
11 the same as for other identification cards and renewals.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
