10 2011 and 2012, the Trojans have extended Frederick A. Douglass High
11 School's State basketball title streak to four consecutive years;

13 WHEREAS, star guard, Stephen Clark scored 51 points in the state
14 championship game and has signed a letter of intent to study and
15 continue his basketball career at Oklahoma State University.
