

1 WHEREAS, the first ten amendments to the Constitution of the
2 United States is commonly referred to as the Bill of Rights; and

3 WHEREAS, the Bill of Rights is the single most powerful and
4 successful assertion of individual rights and liberties ever
5 written; and

6 WHEREAS, the Bill of Rights is one of history's most important
7 and influential documents, with an ingenious balance of personal
8 freedoms and political principles, that has proven dynamic and
9 durable becoming the global road map for human rights and the basic
10 demand of people everywhere seeking freedom from oppression.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION
12 OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
13 CONCURRING THEREIN:

14 THAT the State Capitol Preservation Commission or designee is
15 hereby authorized to permit and arrange for the placement on the
16 State Capitol grounds of a suitable monument displaying the first
17 ten amendments to the Constitution of the United States, commonly
18 referred to as the Bill of Rights. This monument shall be designed,
19 constructed, and placed on the State Capitol grounds by private
20 entities at no expense to the state. The State Capitol Preservation
21 Commission or designee is authorized to assist private entities in
22 selecting a location for the monument and arranging a suitable time
23 for its placement.
