10 An Act relating to courts; authorizing district court
11 judges to carry firearms under certain circumstances;
12 providing for codification; and providing an
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 129 of Title 20, unless there is
17 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A district judge, **municipal judge**, or retired district judge who
19 receives a statement from the appropriate retirement system
20 verifying the status of the person as a retired district judge, may
21 carry a firearm on his or her person anywhere in the state to use
22 only for personal protection if the person has successfully
23 completed an approved course of firearm training conducted by a
24 state-certified firearms instructor which meets the minimum

1 requirements for firearms training as set forth by the Council on
2 Law Enforcement Education and Training.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
