14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 75 O.S. 2011, Section 14, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 14. A. The following officers shall be entitled to
18 ~~receive as soon as available from the state without cost~~ purchase
19 copies in printed or digital form of the ~~printed~~ volumes of the
20 statutes and session laws of the state ~~published or purchased by the~~
21 ~~Legislature, or under its authority, for distribution~~ from the
22 publisher at the prices provided for in the agreement authorized by
23 Section 191 of this title:

24 1. Each state officer, including the Governor and Lieutenant
Governor, the chief administrative officers ~~and assistants~~ of state

1 departments, boards, and commissions, ~~upon written application and~~
2 ~~request submitted to the Chief Clerk-Administrator of the Oklahoma~~
3 ~~House of Representatives, within sixty (60) days of January 1 of~~
4 ~~each year, and said volumes shall be distributed at the discretion~~
5 ~~of the Chief Clerk-Administrator of the Oklahoma House of~~
6 Representatives; provided, the purchases shall be pursuant to a
7 contract between the publisher and the Purchasing Division of the
8 Office of Management and Enterprise Services and pursuant to The
9 Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act; and

10 2. ~~Each member~~ The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives
11 and the Secretary of the Senate for the members and staff of the
12 Legislature; and

13 3. The Justices of the Supreme Court and the Judges of the
14 Court of Criminal Appeals, and the clerk of said Courts; ~~and~~

15 4. The chief administrative officers of the state educational,
16 benevolent, and penal institutions; provided, the purchases, except
17 for purchases by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and
18 the institutions, centers or other constituent agencies of The
19 Oklahoma State System of Higher Education, shall be pursuant to a
20 contract between the publisher and the Purchasing Division of the
21 Office of Management and Enterprise Services and pursuant to The
22 Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act; and

23 5. The judges of the district courts and district court clerks;

- 2 7. County treasurers; ~~and~~
- 3 8. County assessors; ~~and~~
- 4 9. District attorneys and one assistant district attorney in
- 5 each county; provided, the purchases shall be pursuant to a contract
- 6 between the publisher and the Purchasing Division of the Office of
- 7 Management and Enterprise Services and pursuant to The Oklahoma
- 8 Central Purchasing Act; ~~and~~

- 10 11. ~~All members~~ Members of the Oklahoma Congressional
- 11 Delegation; ~~and.~~
- 12 B. The following shall be entitled to receive from the state
- 13 without cost copies of the statutes and session laws to be purchased
- 14 by the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives:
- 15 ~~12.~~ 1. Each library association organized in any county, city,
- 16 or town in this state for the benefit of the public.
- 17 ~~B. Fifty-five (55) copies of the statutes and session laws~~
- 18 ~~shall be furnished to the;~~
- 19 2. The law library of the College of Law of the University of
- 20 Oklahoma, ~~five copies to be kept for use therein and fifty copies~~
- 21 ~~for purposes of exchange.~~
- 22 ~~C. Five (5) copies of the statutes and session laws shall be~~
- 23 ~~placed in the;~~

1 3. The library of Oklahoma State University at Stillwater,
2 Oklahoma, for use therein.

3 ~~D. One hundred ten (110) copies of the statutes and session
4 laws shall be furnished to the; and~~

5 4. The Oklahoma Department of Libraries for its use and
6 exchange purposes.

7 ~~E. The Chief Clerk-Administrator may, in his discretion,
8 furnish from any copies of such laws on hand to state officers other
9 than those specified in this section for the use of their offices.~~

10 C. Each person or entity provided for in subsection A of this
11 section that intends to purchase digital access or printed copies of
12 the statutes, cumulative supplements to the statutes, or session
13 laws from the publisher shall place the order directly with the
14 publisher and shall furnish a copy of the order to the Chief Clerk
15 of the House of Representatives within thirty (30) days after the
16 order is placed with the publisher.

17 SECTION 2. REPEALER 75 O.S. 2011, Sections 13 and 17,
18 are hereby repealed.

19 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
