13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1132B of Title 47, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. If any service or transaction which a motor license agent is  
18 authorized by law to provide is administered through any state  
19 agency by means of an electronic transaction or online system, such  
20 agency shall include a step where the individual must select between  
21 any motor license agent in the state and the agency for processing  
22 the service or transaction. This section shall not apply to  
23 registrations processed pursuant to Section 1120 of Title 47 of the  
24 Oklahoma Statutes.

1 B. Motor license agents selected as provided in subsection A of  
2 this section shall receive all fees provided by statute for the  
3 service or transaction processed by the motor license agent through  
4 any electronic transaction or online system administered by a state  
5 agency.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
