9 An Act relating to torts; providing immunity from  
10 civil liability for certain actions during a natural  
11 disaster or catastrophic event; providing for  
12 codification; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5.9 of Title 76, unless there is  
17 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 Any individual, business or school that renders emergency care,  
19 aid, shelter or other assistance during a natural disaster or  
20 catastrophic event shall not be liable for damages resulting from  
21 the rendering of emergency care, aid, shelter or assistance unless  
22 the damage was caused by the gross negligence or willful or wanton  
23 misconduct of the individual or entity rendering the emergency care,  
24 aid, shelter or assistance.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
