10 An Act relating to schools; creating the Oklahoma
11 Extracurricular Activities Accountability Act;
12 providing definition; prohibiting school districts
13 from being a member of a school athletic association
14 unless certain requirements are met; requiring
15 compliance with the Oklahoma Open Records and
16 Oklahoma Open Meeting Acts; requiring certain audits;
17 and providing for codification.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 27-101 of Title 70, unless there
21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma
23 Extracurricular Activities Accountability Act".

24 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 27-102 of Title 70, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 As used in the Oklahoma Extracurricular Activities
2 Accountability Act, a "school athletic association" means any
3 private organization or association which charges the school or
4 school district a membership fee, retains a portion of revenue
5 generated by the interscholastic activities or contests of the
6 member schools, and provides the coordination, supervision and
7 regulation of the interscholastic activities and contests of the
8 member schools.

9 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 27-103 of Title 70, unless there
11 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 A public school or school district shall not be a member of any
13 school athletic association unless that association has adopted a
14 written policy that requires the following:

15 1. All records of the association to be made accessible
16 consistent with the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Records Act;

17 2. All meetings of the association to be open and conducted in
18 a manner consistent with the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Meeting
19 Act, including specifically the notice and agenda, voting and
20 executive session requirements; and

21 3. An annual financial audit and a compliance audit of all
22 funds of the association in accordance with the auditing standards
23 set forth in the Oklahoma Public School Audit Law. In addition, the
24 association shall have performance audits conducted of the

1 operations of the association. A performance audit shall be
2 conducted no later than December 31, 2014, and by December 31 every
3 five (5) years thereafter.
