11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1008.1 of Title 56, unless there  
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 At the time of enrollment, a Medicaid-eligible individual shall  
16 be required to designate a primary care physician, a pharmacy and a  
17 hospital in which to receive Medicaid services.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
