12 areas under certain circumstances - codification -
13 emergency]

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 50 of Title 80, unless there is
17 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 Should any highways or roads located on any property owned and
19 operated by the United States Army Corps of Engineers within the
20 State of Oklahoma close or fail to open for any amount of time due
21 to loss of federal funds in a federal government shutdown or for any
22 other reason, the county in which the road or highway is located may
23 open and maintain the road or highway. This shall be accomplished
24 upon a majority vote of the board of county commissioners that
declares the road or highway is needed for an emergency route.

1 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
