13 ~~BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:~~

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2-103 of Title 27A, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
18 for the Secretary of Energy and Environment or the successor cabinet
19 position having authority over the Department of Environmental
20 Quality to be designated the "Environmental Remediation Revolving
21 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
22 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
23 Secretary from Natural Resource Damage Assessments on behalf of the
24 State, pursuant to paragraph 4 of subsection A of Section 1-2-101 of

1 Title 27A, that are not designated for deposit to any other fund as
2 authorized by law. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund
3 are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the
4 Secretary to perform the duties imposed by law. Expenditures from
5 the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer
6 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the
7 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and
8 payment.

9 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2-104 of Title 27A, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
13 for the Secretary of Energy and Environment or the successor cabinet
14 position having authority over the Department of Environmental
15 Quality to be designated the "Environmental Programs Revolving
16 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
17 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
18 Secretary from appropriations, fees, charges, penalties, and any
19 other sources that are not designated for deposit to any other fund
20 as authorized by law. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund
21 are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the
22 Secretary to perform the duties imposed by law. Expenditures from
23 the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer
24 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the

1 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and
2 payment.

3 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.

4 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
