9 An Act relating to criminal procedure; prohibiting  
10 non-law-enforcement entities or persons from  
11 participating in roadside traffic stops; providing  
12 for codification; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1115.6 of Title 22, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Under no circumstances may a law enforcement agency or law  
18 enforcement task force authorize or allow a private non-law-  
19 enforcement or nondepartmental entity or person to conduct or  
20 actively participate in a roadside traffic stop or arrest for a  
21 violation of a state traffic law or municipal traffic ordinance.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
