11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 64, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 64. A. Upon a conviction for any misdemeanor
15 punishable by imprisonment in any jail, in relation to which no fine
16 is prescribed by law, the court or a jury may impose a fine on the
17 offender not exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) in addition
18 to the imprisonment prescribed.

19 B. Upon a conviction for any felony punishable by imprisonment
20 in any jail or prison, in relation to which no fine is prescribed by
21 law, the court or a jury may impose a fine on the offender not
22 exceeding Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) in addition to the
23 imprisonment prescribed.

1 C. Upon conviction of any misdemeanor or any felony as provided
2 in subsection A and B of this section, a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00)
3 shall be assessed. All fees collected pursuant to this section
4 shall be paid to the Department of Corrections and deposited in the
5 Sex Offender Electronic Monitoring Revolving Fund.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
