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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.5.1 of Title 74, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma  
17 Office of Privatization Act".

18 B. There is hereby created the Oklahoma Office of Privatization  
19 under the regulatory authority of the Office of Management and  
20 Enterprise Services. The purpose of the Office of Privatization is  
21 to establish an entity to be the repository of the best  
22 privatization and surplus asset sales practices, as well as having  
23 expertise to select projects or services for privatization and  
24 designate assets as surplus, be capable of rapid evaluation and

1 response to unsolicited privatization proposals and have the ability  
2 to oversee the contracting for privatization opportunities.

3 C. The Secretary of Finance, in the capacity of the Director of  
4 the Office of Management and Enterprise Services or a successor  
5 agency, shall organize, with the approval of the Governor, a  
6 governing board to assist in the functions outlined in the  
7 Governor's Task Force recommendations. Initial appointments to this  
8 Board shall be made no later than September 1, 2013. The Governor  
9 shall determine the number of members and qualifications necessary  
10 as the Governor deems appropriate.

11 D. The Secretary of Finance, with approval of and on behalf of  
12 a majority of the initial members appointed to the Board of the  
13 Oklahoma Office of Privatization, shall be authorized to promulgate  
14 rules as necessary to implement the provisions of this act and may  
15 report legislative recommendations as the Board deems necessary to  
16 further implement the provisions of this act.

17 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
18 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
