12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1320.1 of Title 59, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Pursuant to Section 1320 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes, a
17 bondsman is authorized to write bonds on up to ten (10) defendants
18 per year January 1 through December 31 in each county outside his or
19 her resident county. For purposes of determining the ten-defendant
20 bond limit pursuant to Section 1320 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma
21 Statutes, the bondsman shall consider each date a bond or bonds are
22 written on a single individual as being one of the ten-defendant
23 limit notwithstanding any previous bonds which have been written on

1 that same individual. The ten-defendant limit does not apply in
2 counties without a registered bondsman in such county.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
