9 An Act relating to public health; prohibiting certain
10 emergency contraception to be available to certain
11 individuals without a prescription; requiring certain
12 emergency contraception to be dispensed by
13 pharmacists to certain individuals without a
14 prescription; providing for codification; and
15 providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-748 of Title 63, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 Plan B One-Step, or its generic equivalent, also known as the
21 "morning-after" emergency contraceptive, shall not be available to
22 women under the age of seventeen (17) without a prescription. Such
23 emergency contraceptive shall be dispensed by pharmacists to women
24 seventeen (17) years of age and older without a prescription.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
