8 **[Sex Offenders Registration Act - persons and crimes**
9 **- effective date]**

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2011, Section 582, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 582. A. The provisions of the Sex Offenders
15 Registration Act shall apply to any person residing, working or
16 attending school within the State of Oklahoma who, after November 1,
17 1989, has been convicted, whether upon a verdict or plea of guilty
18 or upon a plea of nolo contendere, or received a suspended sentence
19 or any probationary term, or is currently serving a sentence or any
20 form of probation or parole for a crime or an attempt to commit a
21 crime provided for in Section 843.5 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
22 Statutes if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation
23 as those terms are defined in Section 1-1-105 of Title 10A of the
24 Oklahoma Statutes, Section 681, if the offense involved sexual

1 assault, Section 741, if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual
2 exploitation, Section 843.1, if the offense involved sexual abuse or
3 sexual exploitation, Section 852.1, if the offense involved sexual
4 abuse of a child, 865 et seq., 885, 886, 888, 891, if the offense
5 involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation, 1021, 1021.2, 1021.3,
6 1024.2, 1040.12a, 1040.13, 1040.13a, 1087, 1088, 1111.1, 1114 or
7 1123 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

8 B. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall
9 apply to any person who after November 1, 1989, resides, works or
10 attends school within the State of Oklahoma and who has been
11 convicted or received a suspended sentence at any time in any court
12 of another state, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam,
13 American Samoa, the Northern Mariana Islands and the United States
14 Virgin Islands, a federal court, an Indian tribal court, a military
15 court, or a court of a foreign country for a crime, attempted crime
16 or a conspiracy to commit a crime which, if committed or attempted
17 in this state, would be a crime, an attempt to commit a crime or a
18 conspiracy to commit a crime provided for in any of said laws listed
19 in subsection A of this section.

20 C. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall
21 apply to any person who resides, works or attends school within the
22 State of Oklahoma and who has received a deferred judgment at any
23 time in any court of another state, the District of Columbia, Puerto
24 Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the Northern Mariana Islands and the

1 United States Virgin Islands, a federal court, an Indian tribal
2 court, a military court, or a court of a foreign country for a
3 crime, attempted crime or a conspiracy to commit a crime which, if
4 committed or attempted or conspired to be committed in this state,
5 would be a crime, an attempt to commit a crime or a conspiracy to
6 commit a crime provided for in Section 843.5 of Title 21 of the
7 Oklahoma Statutes if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual
8 exploitation as those terms are defined in Section 1-1-105 of Title
9 10A of the Oklahoma Statutes, Section 681, if the offense involved
10 sexual assault, Section 741, if the offense involved sexual abuse or
11 sexual exploitation, Section 748, if the offense involved human
12 trafficking for commercial sex, Section 843.1, if the offense
13 involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation, Section 852.1, if the
14 offense involved sexual abuse of a child, 865 et seq., 885, 886,
15 888, 891, if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual
16 exploitation, 1021, 1021.2, 1021.3, 1024.2, 1040.12a, 1040.13,
17 1040.13a, 1087, 1088, 1111.1, 1114 or 1123 of Title 21 of the
18 Oklahoma Statutes. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration
19 Act shall not apply to any such person while the person is
20 incarcerated in a maximum or medium correctional institution of the
21 Department of Corrections.

22 D. On the effective date of this act, any person registered as
23 a sex offender pursuant to Section 741 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
24 Statutes shall be summarily removed from the Sex Offender Registry

1 by the Department of Corrections and all law enforcement agencies of
2 any political subdivision of this state, unless the offense involved
3 sexual abuse or sexual exploitation.

4 E. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall
5 not apply to any such person who has received a criminal history
6 records expungement for a conviction in another state for a crime or
7 attempted crime which, if committed or attempted in this state,
8 would be a crime or an attempt to commit a crime provided for in any
9 said laws listed in subsection A of this section.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
