8 An Act relating to virtual education; authorizing an  
9 online provider to be a site; requiring reporting of  
10 certain student data; providing for codification;  
11 providing an effective date; and declaring an  
12 emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-145.6 of Title 70, unless  
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. A virtual education provider that offers full-time virtual  
18 education to students who are not residents of the school district  
19 with which the provider is contracted shall be considered a site  
20 within each school district with which the provider contracts and  
21 subject to the accountability system established pursuant to Section  
22 1210.545 of this title.

23 B. The virtual education provider and the school district with  
24 which it contracts are hereby directed to identify those students

1 who are full-time virtual students and do not live in the physical  
2 boundaries of the district. The district and provider shall submit  
3 as necessary to the State Department of Education detailed data on  
4 the performance of non-resident students who are receiving full-time  
5 instruction.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
8 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
