11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 37 O.S. 2011, Section 8, as
13 amended by Section 1, Chapter 210, O.S.L. 2013 (37 O.S. Supp. 2013,
14 Section 8), is amended to read as follows:

15 Except as provided in Section ~~2~~ 8a of this ~~act~~ title, any person
16 who shall, in any public place, or in or upon any passenger coach,
17 streetcar, or in or upon any other vehicle commonly used for the
18 transportation of passengers, or in or about any depot, platform,
19 waiting station or room, drink or otherwise consume any intoxicating
20 liquor unless authorized by the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control
21 Act, intoxicating substance, or intoxicating compound of any kind,
22 or inhale glue, paint or other intoxicating substance, or if any
23 person shall be drunk or intoxicated in any public or private road,
24 or in any passenger coach, streetcar, or any public place or

1 building, or at any public gathering, from drinking or consuming
2 such intoxicating liquor, intoxicating substance or intoxicating
3 compound or from inhalation of glue, paint or other intoxicating
4 substance, or if any person shall be drunk or intoxicated from any
5 cause and shall disturb the peace of any person, ~~he~~ the person shall
6 be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be
7 punished by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00), nor more
8 than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), or by imprisonment for not less
9 than five (5) days nor more than thirty (30) days, or by both such
10 fine and imprisonment; provided that, notwithstanding any other
11 provision of law, if such a person has three (3) previous
12 convictions of intoxication from drinking liquor, the person may be
13 guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by
14 imprisonment in the county jail for one year.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
