12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be  
14 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 311A.19 of Title 36,  
15 unless there is created duplication in numbering reads as follows:

16 All insurers licensed in Oklahoma and who write commercial  
17 insurance shall provide, upon written request of a client of the  
18 insurer, the commercial loss history of the insurer for the past 36  
19 months. The insurer shall provide the requested information within  
20 fifteen (15) calendar days of the client's request. An insurer who  
21 fails to comply with this section without good cause shall be  
22 subject to a fine of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each day the  
23 insurer fails to comply with the request. The fine shall be made  
24 payable to the Oklahoma Insurance Department.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
