9 An Act relating to the Alternative Fuels Technician
10 Certification Act; amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section
11 130.20, which relates to work of technician by
12 noncertified person; providing exception for persons
13 modifying their own vehicle; stating restriction;
14 providing punishment for violations; and declaring an
15 emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 130.20, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 130.20. A. After September 1, 1991, it shall be
20 unlawful for any person to perform the work or offer, by
21 advertisement or otherwise, to perform the work of an alternative
22 fuels equipment technician until such person has qualified and is
23 certified as an alternative fuels equipment technician.

24 B. Beginning September 1, 1995, it shall be unlawful for any
person to perform work or offer, by advertisement or otherwise, to

1 perform the work of an alternative fuels compression technician
2 until such person has qualified and is certified as an alternative
3 fuels compression technician.

4 C. Beginning November 1, 1998, it shall be unlawful for any
5 person to perform the work or offer, by advertisement or otherwise,
6 to perform the work of an electric vehicle technician until such
7 person has qualified and is certified as an electric vehicle
8 technician. Electric vehicles that have a manufacturer's warranty
9 shall be serviced by an authorized new car dealer. Any vehicle
10 manufacturer's training center located in the state, which offers
11 alternative fuel and electric vehicle courses meeting new car
12 manufacturing requirements, shall be exempted from this act.

13 ~~Provided, nothing~~ D. Nothing in the Alternative Fuels
14 Technician Certification Act shall be construed to prohibit a
15 noncertified person from converting the engine of a farm tractor, as
16 defined in Section 1-118 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to an
17 engine fueled by alternative fuels, as long as such farm tractor is
18 not operated on the roads and highways of this state.

19 E. Nothing in the Alternative Fuels Technician Certification
20 Act shall be construed to prohibit a person certified as an
21 alternative fuels equipment technician, alternative fuels
22 compression technician, or electric vehicle technician from
23 performing work on a vehicle or equipment owned by the person.

1 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
