13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-7-616 of Title 10A, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. For the purposes of establishing and operating a charter
18 school, pursuant to the provisions of Section 3-130 et seq. of Title
19 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Board of Juvenile Affairs may serve
20 as the governing body of the charter school and may take any action
21 necessary to serve in such capacity and in accordance with rules of
22 the State Board of Education. The Board of Juvenile Affairs may
23 promulgate rules as necessary for the establishment and operation of

1 such charter school and shall establish policies and provide
2 oversight for any such charter school.

3 B. The Executive Director of the Office of Juvenile Affairs
4 shall provide for the administration and operation of any charter
5 school established and operated by the Office of Juvenile Affairs.

6 C. The Executive Director of the Office of Juvenile Affairs may
7 employ instructional and administrative personnel necessary for the
8 operation of a charter school and may contract with such personnel
9 for the terms and conditions of their employment or for the services
10 provided. Instructional and administrative personnel employed by
11 the Office of Juvenile Affairs shall be in the unclassified service.
12 Such personnel shall be eligible for membership or participation in
13 the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma.

14 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
