8 An Act relating to medical liability actions;
9 prohibiting admissibility of certain action;
10 prohibiting use of certain action for certain
11 determination or presumption; providing for
12 codification; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1712 of Title 63, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A physician's failure to comply with or a physician's breach of
18 any federal statute, regulation, program, guideline or other
19 provision shall not be admissible, used to determine the standard of
20 care, or the legal basis for a presumption of negligence in any
21 medical liability action in this state.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
