11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 51-101.1 of Title 11, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. For all collective bargaining agreements authorized pursuant
16 to Section 51-101 et seq. of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes
17 entered on or after the effective date of this act, such collective
18 bargaining agreements shall include a provision specifying the
19 collective bargaining agreement shall not apply to police officers
20 that were found to have used excessive force as defined in Section
21 34.1 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes in performing their duties
22 and were terminated for that act.

23 B. Any officer seeking relief to appeal his or her termination
24 for use of excessive force may petition the district court. The

1 officer may be eligible for reinstatement if the court determines
2 such termination was based on an arbitrary, capricious, or any other
3 basis prohibited by law.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
