12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 3 of Article V of the Oklahoma
14 Constitution, there is hereby ordered the following legislative
15 referendum which shall be filed with the Secretary of State and
16 addressed to the Governor of the state, who shall submit the same to
17 the people for their approval or rejection at the next General
18 Election.

19 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 158 of Title 17, unless there is
21 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A. All electric service providers operating electric generation
23 and transmission facilities in this state shall, by January 1, 2017,
24 have installed and operational electromagnetic shield protection

1 technology on electric infrastructure and facilities identified as
2 critical for such protection by the Southwest Power Pool Regional
3 Transmission Organization.

4 B. The electric service providers shall utilize electromagnetic
5 shield protection technology which shall at a minimum meet the
6 engineering design guidelines for protecting critical communications
7 and data centers as outlined in Department of Defense MIL-STD-188-
8 125-1 or a successor standard adopted by the United States
9 Department of Defense.

10 C. All electric utility providers are authorized to implement a
11 rate increase to recover the cost of installing such equipment.
12 Public utility providers regulated by the Corporation Commission
13 shall be granted a customer rate increase necessary to recoup the
14 costs associated with implementing the equipment, as required by
15 subsection A of this section, within five (5) years. Municipalities
16 and self-governing electric cooperatives are authorized to implement
17 a customer charge in an amount deemed necessary to implement the
18 requirements of this section.

19 SECTION 3. The Ballot Title for the proposed act shall be in
20 the following form:

23 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

1 This measure requires electric transmission operators in this
2 state to install certain electromagnetic shield protection on
3 critical equipment by January 1, 2017. There shall be a rate
4 increase to recover costs of installing this equipment.

8 SECTION 4. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall,
9 immediately after the passage of this order for legislative

12 legislative referendum, including the Ballot Title set forth in
13 SECTION 3, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the
14 Attorney General.
