12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-728g of Title 63, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Notwithstanding any other provision of state or federal law, no  
17 employer shall be required to provide or pay for any benefit or  
18 service related to abortion or contraception through the provision  
19 of health insurance to his or her employees.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
