12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.45.j1 of Title 74, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law or agency rule to
17 the contrary, any bid submissions made by a state agency or any
18 political subdivision pursuant to authorized sole source bidding
19 procedures established by the provisions of Section 85.45j of Title
20 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, which substitute an item with one that
21 is alike in quality and design or which meets the required
22 specifications of the bid shall be considered and shall not be
23 prohibited.

1 B. In addition, no sole source bid proposal shall require any
2 limitation that materials must be supplied from a vendor within any
3 specific geographical area. Geographic preference for vendors
4 inside the geographical boundaries may be given, but only when the
5 cost is the same or similar.

6 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
7 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

8 The Office of Management and Enterprise Services is authorized
9 to promulgate rules as necessary to implement the provisions of this
10 act.

11 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
