9 A Concurrent Resolution approving the transfer of  
10 certain personal property and real property under the  
11 jurisdiction of the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation  
12 Commission to certain government entity; and  
13 directing distribution.

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA  
15 LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

16 THAT, for purposes of public recreation and historic  
17 preservation of a location of particular interest to both the State  
18 of Oklahoma and the Chickasaw Nation, and pursuant to Section 2224  
19 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Oklahoma Legislature  
20 hereby approves the transfer of personal property and real property  
21 containing approximately 588.5 acres at the area known as Boggy  
22 Depot State Park owned by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation  
23 Department and operated and maintained under the jurisdiction of the  
24 Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission to the Chickasaw Nation,

1 an American Indian tribe properly considered an "agency of  
2 government" per Section 2224 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes  
3 and which is also an eligible sponsor for land and water  
4 conservation funds under the federal Land and Water Conservation  
5 Fund program.

6 THAT the real estate and personal property transfer shall be  
7 subject to the authority and requirements in Section 2224 of Title  
8 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

9 THAT, of the property transferred, all water and mineral rights  
10 shall be retained by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department  
11 and/or the State of Oklahoma.

12 THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Governor,  
13 the Lieutenant Governor, the Attorney General, the Oklahoma Tourism  
14 and Recreation Commission, the Executive Director of the Oklahoma  
15 Tourism and Recreation Department and Governor Bill Anoatubby of the  
16 Chickasaw Nation.
