9 **[ bicycle routes - designating Route 66 as Oklahoma's  
10 Official Bicycle Route - directing distribution ]**

11 WHEREAS, a nationwide effort has been launched to designate  
12 Route 66 as the Official Bicycle Route within each state it passes  
13 through; and

14 WHEREAS, Oklahoma has over 430 driveable miles along Route 66,  
15 the most of any state in the country; and

16 WHEREAS, over thirty-two (32) municipalities through which Route  
17 66 runs have offered their overwhelming support to designate Route  
18 66 as Oklahoma's Official Bicycle Route.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF  
20 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

21 SECTION 1. Route 66 extending throughout the State of Oklahoma  
22 shall be designated as Oklahoma's Official Bicycle Route.

23 SECTION 2. The Department of Transportation shall submit an  
24 application to the American Association of State Highway and

1 Transportation Officials with the intention of adding Route 66 to  
2 the U.S. Bicycle Route System.

3 SECTION 3. The Department of Transportation or any local  
4 municipality which the route runs through may erect suitable  
5 permanent markers designating the route.

6 SECTION 4. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to  
7 distribute copies of this resolution to the Department of  
8 Transportation.
