9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma School of Science and  
11 Mathematics; making an appropriation to the Board of  
12 Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and  
13 Mathematics; stating purpose; requiring expenditure  
14 of certain sum for certain purpose; requiring  
15 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;  
16 requiring performance measures; providing for duties  
17 and compensation of employees; limiting the maximum  
18 salary of the Director; providing budgetary  
19 limitations; making certain students eligible for  
20 certain programs; requiring budgeting of certain  
21 funds in certain years; providing lapse dates;  
22 requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting  
23 certain budget procedures; and providing an effective  
24 date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of  
Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics from any  
monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of  
the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the sum

1 of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be  
2 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma School of  
3 Science and Mathematics by law.

4 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act,  
5 the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be expended  
6 for the purpose of developing and offering pilot outreach programs  
7 in science and mathematics as directed in Section 1210.404 of Title  
8 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

9 SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the Board  
10 of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics shall  
11 budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

19 The Board of Trustees shall develop outcome-based performance  
20 measures for each budget category.

21 SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
22 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
23 upon the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics by law shall be  
24 set by the Director. The salary of the Director of the shall not

1 exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly  
2 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014. The Oklahoma School of  
3 Science and Mathematics for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014,  
4 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-  
5 time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures  
6 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized  
7 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the  
8 Oklahoma Statutes:

12 SECTION 5. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
13 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
14 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014 (hereafter FY-14) or may be  
15 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 (hereafter FY-15).  
16 Funds budgeted for FY-14 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
17 2014, and must be expended by November 15, 2014. Any funds  
18 remaining after November 15, 2014, and not budgeted for FY-15, shall  
19 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
20 year. Funds budgeted for FY-15 may be encumbered only through June  
21 30, 2015. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2015, shall lapse  
22 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
23 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
24 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-14, and not required to pay

1 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-15, after  
2 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
3 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
4 from the FY-14 budget work program and after such revision has been  
5 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

6 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective September 1, 2013.

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
