9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Office of the Lieutenant
11 Governor; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 providing lapse dates; requiring certain budget
procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures;
and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
17 Lieutenant Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
18 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
19 ending June 30, 2014, the sum of _____ Dollars
20 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
21 imposed upon the Office of the Lieutenant Governor by law.

22 SECTION 2. Appropriations made by this act, not including
23 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
24 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014 (hereafter FY-14) or may be

1 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 (hereafter FY-15).
2 Funds budgeted for FY-14 may be encumbered only through June 30,
3 2014, and must be expended by November 15, 2014. Any funds
4 remaining after November 15, 2014, and not budgeted for FY-15, shall
5 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
6 year. Funds budgeted for FY-15 may be encumbered only through June
7 30, 2015. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2015, shall lapse
8 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
9 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
10 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-14, and not required to pay
11 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-15, after
12 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
13 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
14 from the FY-14 budget work program and after such revision has been
15 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

16 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective September 1, 2013.
