9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Office of Management and  
11 Enterprise Services; making appropriations; stating  
12 purposes; providing lapse dates; requiring certain  
budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget  
procedures; and providing an effective date.

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15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of  
17 Management and Enterprise Services from any monies not otherwise  
18 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for  
19 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_  
20 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform  
21 the duties imposed upon the Office of Management and Enterprise  
22 Services by law.

23 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of  
24 Management and Enterprise Services from any monies not otherwise

1 appropriated from the Public Building Fund of the State Treasury for  
2 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
3 (\$0.00) to be transferred to the Building and Facility Revolving  
4 Fund created in Section 63.1 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes  
5 for the purpose of maintaining state buildings operated by the  
6 Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

7 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of  
8 Management and Enterprise Services from any monies not otherwise  
9 appropriated from the Public Building Fund of the State Treasury for  
10 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
11 (\$0.00) to be transferred to the Building and Facility Revolving  
12 Fund created in Section 63.1 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes  
13 for the purpose of maintaining state buildings operated by the  
14 Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

15 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
16 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
17 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014 (hereafter FY-14) or may be  
18 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 (hereafter FY-15).  
19 Funds budgeted for FY-14 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
20 2014, and must be expended by November 15, 2014. Any funds  
21 remaining after November 15, 2014, and not budgeted for FY-15, shall  
22 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
23 year. Funds budgeted for FY-15 may be encumbered only through June  
24 30, 2015. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2015, shall lapse

1 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
2 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
3 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-14, and not required to pay  
4 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-15, after  
5 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
6 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
7 from the FY-14 budget work program and after such revision has been  
8 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

9 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective September 1, 2013.

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
